1. ORGANIC AGRICULTURE

As we came across several agri related activities, it is mainly to promote organic agriculture to our local framers. And this year we have focused on giving training programmes for BD school students of Inba Seva Sangam Organisation, which has been located in Sevapur of Kadavur and local farmers of Tiruchirapalli.

On this training programmes, we insists the important of water management and cropping patterns in upcoming years and how the cropping patterns helps us to maintain save and manage water. It also brings wide knowledge in soil fertility, organic manure and methods to promote organic farming in our local area.

Nearly 30 farmers have been benefited in a month. We also met local organisations like Vaanagam, Kudumbam and Inba Seva Sangam to enrich the wider knowledge in Organic Farming and they also give us training on this area.

2. QUALITY EDUCATION

According to this saying, our organisation focused on Quality Education in wider manner. Here, we should specially mention our village volunteering team called "**Enathu Kanavu Gramam**"-(*The Team of Intellectuals*) of Nadupatti. They are the main pillar of our success in quality education.

They have formed the alumni group of local government school and collected fund for the development purpose of our local primary school. And this year, we have conducted various skill training programmes and motivational classes for 1st to 9th standard students and career guidance programme for 12th standard students of Nadupatti Higher Secondary school. This brings good relationship with parents and the teachers too. Even the student strength also increased from this academic year.

By seeing these activities, "**Aravind Eye Hospital Madurai**" requested us to conduct "**Summer Camp**" in their **Ambasamuthiram CSR project**. This Summer Camp was held for 5 days for their model school. Nearly 150 children (it includes other local school children) have been participated. Our volunteer team consists of 6 members have given the training on this camp. Even children's parents were also participated actively to encourage their children.

Activities like Sylambum, Singing, Story Telling, Dance, Scientific Crafts, Drawing, Play back Theatre, and Other motivational classes were conducted in this camp.
